Dear EAA members,

We are now approaching the end of 2017 and as is customary, I would like to highlight the major events of our yearly activity. First of all, I would mention the first edition of the EAA Summer school on 'Testis Histology and Pathology for Clinical Andrologists and Embryologists'. The course was held in Zagreb (Croatia) and it was open to both clinical andrologists and biologists/biotechnologists. I would like to thank again the chairs of the course, Profs Davor Jezek (director of the EAA Centre in Zagreb) and Niels Joergensen (director of the EAA Centre in Copenhagen) for having organized such a successful event. We are looking forward to the next edition in 2019.

The 'EAA Ultrasound School', established in 2016, has reached to the end of its second edition and will continue from January 2018 (third edition). The widespread geographic origin of the fellows reflects the success of this unique EAA course and the growing interest towards this discipline all over Europe and in North Africa. The school, organized by Dr. Francesco Lotti (Florence) and Prof. Andrea Isidori (Rome), ends with an exit exam and successful participants are awarded with a prestigious certificate, the 'EAA certified sonographers for male genital tract and penile colour-Doppler ultrasound'. On behalf of the EAA, I would like to thank the co-chairs for their outstanding work.

This year, the EAA has expanded its educational activities also to the members of the European Society of Endocrinology (ESE). A very well-attended educational course on 'Clinical Andrology for endocrinologists' was organized in Lisbon, during ECE2017, as part of the EAA/ESE agreement on common educational and scientific activities. We are going to further strengthen our collaboration with the ESE by organizing the first EAA Symposium during ECE2018 (Barcelona) and by holding an ESE lecture during ECA2018.

As you all know, our major scientific event, ECA 2018, will take place in Budapest (Hungary) in October 11–13, 2018. The preliminary programme is already available on the congress website, and you are welcome to visit it for further information. The EC has decided to offer 10 dedicated travel grants to EAA members willing to present abstracts during ECA2018.

Finally, as announced in the previous Newsletters in June, in 2018, we are going to publish in 'Andrology' a series of EAA Guidelines. The first of them will be on Management of Oligo-Asthenozoospermia.

Also in 2017, the number of EAA members has increased steadily, and I take the opportunity to warmly welcome all new members.

MALE REPRODUCTION, MALE AND FEMALE SEXUAL DYSFUNCTION, ANDRO-GENETICS and EPIGENETICS, ART and SPERMATOLOGY, SURGICAL-ANDROLOGY, UROGENITAL TRACT INFECTIONS, BASIC ANDROLOGY, *IN VITRO* SPERMATOGENESIS, ONCO-ANDROLOGY

The School was organized jointly by the EAA training centres of Zagreb and Copenhagen. The School was attended by 18 participants, most of them coming from other certified EAA Centres. The nature of the course was predominantly practical ('hands-on'), and included the analysis of a significant number of microscopy sessions and a visit to the operational theatre and to the cryobank of testicular tissue. Based on the results of the initial and final test, participants demonstrated a good improvement of knowledge. In the course evaluation, all participants stated that they would highly recommend the course to their peers.

**International Conference on Gonadotropins and Receptors
and 12th International Symposium on GnRH.****The hypothalamic-pituitary-gonadal axis in cancer and
reproduction,****20-23 September 2017, Modena, Italy**

In 2017, the first ICGR-GnRH congress was held in Modena, unifying for the first time the 4th International Conference on Gonadotropins and Receptors and the 12th hypothalamic-pituitary-gonadal axis in cancer and reproduction meeting. This congress was the first attempt to unify these two important international meetings, based on the research about the hypothalamic-pituitary axis. Moreover, it represented an excellent example of collaboration among the European Society of Endocrinology (ESE), the European Academy of Andrology (EAA), the Italian Society of Endocrinology (SIE) and the Italian Society of Andrology and Sexual Medicine (SIAMS). This event was guided and promoted by two benchmarks for global research in the field of reproduction and gonadotropins: Prof. Manuela Simoni and Prof. Ilpo Huhtaniemi.

During the three days of the congress, more than 100 participants attended the event, coming from more than 10 countries around the world and following 33 presentations, organised in eight symposium and five lectures. The symposia covered all novelties in the field of research in gonadotropins and reproduction. Moreover, a peculiar effort was performed to translate and transpose the findings of basic research into the clinical practice. Indeed, not only basic scientists attended the course, but also clinicians, belonging to endocrinology, andrology and gynaecology actively participated to the discussion.

The event was further enriched by 16 oral communications, selected from the contributions of young investigators. Overall, the feedback received from the participants was extremely positive and we are looking forward to the future editions of this successful meeting.

EAA Multicentre Ultrasound Study: An Update

The multicentre study 'Standardization of male genital tract colour-Doppler ultrasound parameters in healthy, fertile men' (see <http://www.andrologyacademy.net/studies.aspx>) is progressing well.

So far, 237 subjects have been enrolled, 237 scrotal and 177 transrectal ultrasound have been performed, 200 blood samples have been collected. The study is approaching to its final stages and results will be presented during ECA2018.
