Note from the President

Dear EAA Members,



According to the tradition, this Newsletter closes the EAA activities of the year. The second half of 2021 was still affected by the never-ending COVID-19 crisis, but the EAA Council and Office have remained active. We were also present at a few andrology events, including the European Fertility Week (online) and the first since 2019 onsite meeting of the Italian Society of Andrology & Sexual Medicine (SIAMS) in Bologna. Since 2021 we started a close collaboration with ESHRE Special group of interest in andrology through participation in campus activities.

Despite difficulties with meetings, we have managed to organize the 2nd Budapest School and the EAA clinical andrologist exam in late summer, with face-to-face participation. I warmly thank the Hungarian hosts and extend my congratulations to 14 new EAA-certified Clinical Andrologists! I am happy to announce that in 2022 all EAA Schools are returning to action and are planned to be held onsite, starting from the EAA Ultrasound School (Florence/Rome) and the the 3rd edition of the Budapest School and Clinical Andrologist exam in early March! The EAA continues to reinforce the old partnership with ESAU through the joint ESAU/EAA session at the EAU congress in March. The EAA initiated a close collaboration with the International Consortium dedicated to Male Contraception (ICMC) and we will be present at the 3rd ICMCs congress in May. The 2022 calendar is brimming with meetings and will culminate in October in Barcelona. You can take advantage of available travel grants to attend the schools and all other meetings!

The EAA-initiated ANDRONET COST-action has formally started with the kick-off Management Committee meeting. I take the opportunity to thank Rafael Oliva for his hard work as the ANDRONET's Coordinator.

The mandate of our Chief Editor, Manuela Simoni, ends in 2021. On behalf of the EAA, I would like to thank Manuela for her extraordinary work.

Finally, we have performed a comprehensive internal and external review of the EAA structure and strategy. Although we already changed our rules for membership (with the aim of attracting also young researchers and basic scientists), we need more targeted actions. After a consensus has been found, we shall summon a dedicated General Assembly during the year. Stay tuned!

I wish you all a warm and healthy Christmas and Holidays, and a happy and productive Year 2022. Hope to meet you all at ECA2022!

31 Aug—2 Sept, 2021 Budapest, Hungary



The second edition of the EAA Budapest School held on 31 August-2 September 2021, was organized by the EAA Office and directed by Zsolt Kopa (Budapest) and Csilla Krausz (Florence). The additional faculty members, and participants in a meeting of the EAA Executive Council, included: Giovanni Corona, Davor Ježek, Andrea M. Isidori, Eduard Ruiz-Castañé, Ewa Rajpert-De Meyts and Rafael Oliva.

Due to the travel limitations, the programme was limited to general andrology aspects, which were selected to prepare fellows for the EAA Clinical Andrologist examination. In total, 31 participants (candidates and faculty) from 13 countries were present at the meeting. ANDRONET news



As we have informed you earlier, the European Cooperation in Science and Technology (COST) has approved the EAA-initiated proposal ANDRONET, which has been coordinated by **Rafael Oliva** (Barcelona, Spain).

ANDRONET has three main objectives:

- Improving research coordination and transfer of knowledge in the field of andrology
- Supporting professional education of andrologists
- Enhancing public awareness of male health and its specific problems

The first kick-off meeting of the Management Committee (MC), composed of 1-2 representatives of participating countries, was held online on 27-28 October 2021, and this date marked the official start of the Action which will last four years (until 27-10-2025).

The leaders of the Action and all Working Groups were elected at the mee **Action Chair: Rafael Oliva** (Spain) whose institution (*Fundacio Clinic per a la Recerca Biomedica* (FCRB) in Barcelona is the <u>Action Grant Holder</u> and will provide administration of the Action


